After only a month of practicing at this stage, Miraji was so confident in my skills, that he wanted to put them to a test to determine if I was ready to move on to the next stage! Now, I don't want to brag or anything, but...I passed with flying colors! Those tricky mines couldn't hide from me! Miraji was so thrilled with my success, that he gave me and extra helping of the sweetest banana I have ever had.
